Gram's smocked basket. The materials needed are  
listed below. **If you want a pattern or a 12"  
square hoop let Elaine know by Aug. 1. Her  
email is [brulan61@yahoo.com](mailto:brulan61@yahoo.com)**

### Gram's Smoked Basket Materials:

3/4" flat - 15 spokes 30" long  
12" square hoop  
1/4" flat --- lots for weaving  
#3 round for 4 rows of 3 rod wale weaving  
3/8" flat for rim row  
1/4" flat and medium cane (for wrapping handle)  
5/8 flat oval for rim  
Sea grass  
1/4" flat for lasher  
Several long pieces of med cane for stitching

### DAUPHIN COUNTY

#### East Shore Library, Harrisburg, PA

Take **Interstate 83** North to Colonial Park exit. The library is located at the rear of the Colonial Park Mall, near the intersection of Rt. 83 and Rt. 22. The meeting is in the Lower Level of the Library. Please park in the Mall lot near the rear of the Boscov's store.

### GRAVEL HILL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, PALMYRA, PA

**From I-81:** Take Exit 80, south to Route 22 (about 1 mile). Turn left (east) onto Route 22, proceed approximately 1 mile to Gravel Hill Road. (Green sign says 'Palmyra 6 miles'). Turn right (south) onto Gravel Hill Road and follow for 4.5 miles to white church on right.

**From Route 422:** Go to the "square" in Palmyra, turn north onto N. Railroad Street, continue approximately 1 ½ mile to white church on left.

## DIRECTIONS TO JEAN FOUTZ'S HOUSE JUNE GUILD PICNIC/DYE PARTY

Note: Jean does not live far from the Gravel Hill U.M. Church, where many of our meetings have been held.

From Interstate 81:

Take Exit 80 (Grantville), take 743 South to Route 22 (about 1 mile). Turn left (east) onto Route 22, proceed for approximately 1 mile to Gravel Hill Road (green sign that reads: Palmyra 6 miles), turn right (south) onto Gravel Hill Road. Follow for 4.5 miles to white church on right - Gravel Hill UM Church. Continue past the church to the bottom of the hill and where the cemetery ends, turn left onto Ridge Road and continue to the stop sign. Turn right onto North Forge Road and continue across the railroad tracks to the red light. You'll see a Friendly's, Klick-Lewis Car Dealership and Rite Aid, continue through the red light and travel 9/10 of a mile (on S. Forge Road) and turn left onto Londonderry Blvd. (Lebanon Valley Brethren Home sign on left). Make an immediate right onto S. Queen St. Jean's house is the fifth house on the left. (Foutz name and 1252 is on the lamppost.)

From Harrisburg/Hershey:

If you're coming Route 422 from Hershey, turn right (Route 117 or S. Forge Road) at Klick-Lewis car dealership and continue 9/10 of a mile on S. Forge Road, turn left onto Londonderry Blvd., immediate right onto S. Queen St., fifth house on the left.

From Lebanon:

If you're coming Route 422 from Lebanon, turn left (Route 117 or S. Forge Road) at Klick-Lewis car dealership and continue 9/10 of a mile on S. Forge Road, turn left onto Londonderry Blvd., immediate right onto S. Queen St., fifth house on the left.

From Route 322:

Turn north onto Route 117 at Campbelltown, continue past the airport until you come to a Lebanon Valley Brethren Home sign on the right, turn right onto Londonderry Blvd, and make an immediate right onto S. Queen St., the fifth house on the left.
