OCTOBER 12, 2013 GUILD WEAVE & MEMBERSHIP MEETING

- What:** Weave a spiral beaded bracelet or necklace
Who: Deb Roberson
When: Saturday, October 12, 2013 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
Where: Gravel Hill U.M. Church, Palmyra, PA

Weave a beautiful spiral bracelet or necklace! This project is woven using a basic 8-strand braid using beads. Your bead color choices will spiral around the braid. The kit will include enough pre-strung beads and cording to create a braid up to 18". Sterling Silver end caps and clasp are included in the kit (there will be a variety to choose from). If you wish to create 2 bracelets, additional end caps and clasps will be available at a nominal charge. Kit fee: \$30

Color choices: Deb proposed black as the main color, with other color choices for the accent color; however, she is willing to do two shades of the same color (for example, flat green and silver lined green beads). After you sign up, Deb will contact you to find out what colors you would like.

Due to technical difficulties, a photo was not available to send along with this newsletter. However, Deb will have samples at the Odyssey, along with a sign-up sheet. **You can sign up there, or email Deb before September 25** with your color choices so she can have the beads pre-strung before the class. NOVEMBER 2, 2013 Guild Event

Plan to join a group of guild friends for a road trip to Washington, D.C. to see "A Measure of the Earth: The Cole-Ware Collection of American Baskets". While we did not have enough response in order to charter a bus, we will car-pool to a Metro station, and then take the Metro into D.C. If you are interested in joining us, please contact Donna Kumpf at kumpf4@comcast.net (or see signup sheet at the Odyssey) before October 15 so that we have enough time to organize the details of the trip. Let Donna know if you are willing to drive and how many passengers you can take. Your cost will include your Metrorail fares, and lunch. The Guild will reimburse drivers for the transportation cost to/from the Metro station. Be prepared to do some walking, as we will need to walk a few blocks from Metrorail stations to the museums.

Tentative itinerary: (7:30?) Park at Camp Hill mall, car pool Route 15 South, (pick up site in Gettysburg area for our more southern participants), travel to Metrorail Station where we will park the cars. Ride the Metro into D.C. About a 4 block walk to the Renwick Gallery, visit the gallery and have lunch at the Courtyard Café there. Then, take Metro to the Smithsonian metro station, where we are walking distance from your choice of several Smithsonian museums, then meet (perhaps 4:30?), Metro back to cars and ride home.

The Renwick Gallery is associated with the Smithsonian American Art Museum. A gift of 79 baskets from collectors Steven Cole and Martha Ware more than doubled the museum's collection of contemporary baskets. The exhibition opens on Friday, October 4. Curator talks and basket making demonstrations are scheduled on various dates – for more information, check their online calendar at AmericanArt.si.edu.

DIRECTIONS:

To Gravel Hill United Methodist Church, 131 Gravel Hill Road, Palmyra, PA 17078:

FROM INTERSTATE 81: Exit 80 (Grantville), take 743 South to Route 22 (about 1 mile). Turn left (east) onto Route 22, proceed for approximately 1 mile to Gravel Hill Road (green sign that reads: Palmyra 6 miles), turn right (south) onto Gravel Hill Road. Follow for 4.5 miles to white church on right - Gravel Hill United Methodist Church.

FROM Route 422: Go to the "square" in Palmyra, turn north onto North Railroad Street, continue approximately 1.5 miles to white church on left.

To Jean Foutz's home: Jean's address is 1252 South Queen Street, Palmyra, PA and her phone number is (717) 838-6563.

From INTERSTATE 81: Follow directions to Gravel Hill U.M.C., continuing past church. At the intersection of Gravel Hill Road and Main Street, Palmyra, continue east on Main Street (422 East) until you reach South Forge Road, turn right (Route 117) at Klick-Lewis car dealership and continue 9/10 of a mile on S. Forge Road, turn left onto Londonderry Blvd., immediate right onto S. Queen St., fifth house on the left.

FROM Route 422: continue past square in Palmyra. At Klick-Lewis car dealership, turn right onto South Forge Road (route 117), continue 9/10 of a mile on S. Forge Road, turn left onto Londonderry Blvd., immediate right onto S. Queen St., fifth house on the left.

TO CAMP HILL SHOPPING MALL (BOSCOV'S PARKING LOT):

From Route 15: From south, Camp Hill Mall will be on your left, turn left at light, and go to Boscov's parking lot on far left. From north, go through Camp Hill, look for the Camp Hill mall on your right (you'll see Giant food store then Panera Bread; turn right into Mall, Boscov's is on the far left side of the mall.

From Route 83: At exit 41 take 581 West, continue to Exit 5 (Route 15N/Camp Hill), At end of exit, merge into left lane, you will see the Camp Hill Mall on your left, turn left into Mall, Boscov's will be on the far left.

From Route 81: Take exit 59 to merge onto Route 581 East, continue to Exit 5 (Camp Hill / Route 15N. At end of exit, merge into left lane, you will see the Camp Hill Mall on your left, turn left into Mall; Boscov's will be on the far left.
